Hearing having been held and the matter having been submitted for decision, Workers' Compensation Judge, Christine F. Nelson, finds and orders as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT


- (1) IRMA ROLDAN, born 6/21/57, while employed as a cake decorator, in 7/89, at Newport Beach, California, by Lucky Stores, permissibly self-insured, sustained injury arising out of and occurring in the course of said employment to her right major upper extremity.
- (2) Average weekly earnings at injury were \$ 148.50.
- (3) There is no need for further medical treatment to cure or relieve from the effects of said injury at this time.
- (4) Applicant reasonably incurred medical-legal expense of Orange County Medical Clinic.
- (5) There is no rateable permanent disability.
- (6) The deposition attorney fee of \$210.00 appears reasonable.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that, with the exception of the lien of Orange County Medical Clinic, applicant take nothing from the defendant.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that defendant pay the deposition attorney fee of \$210.00.
