MATTER having been heard November 5, 1996 and regularly submitted for decision, The Honorable RICHARD LEE, Workers' Compensation Judge, finds, awards and orders as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- (1) Applicant MARTHA TORRE De FUGET, born November 15, 1945, while employed as a School Teacher on June 20th, 1995 at Santa Ana, California, by the SANTA ANA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT, permissibly self-insured, sustained an injury arising out of and occurring in the course of said employment to her low back.
- (2) Said injury caused NO ratable permanent disability (0%).
- (3) Applicant is NOT entitled to further medical treatment to cure or relieve from the effects of said injury.
- (4) Medical-legal costs are allowed, payable to RICHARD I. WOODS, M.D.
- (5) Self-procured medical treatment is to be adjusted by the parties.
- (6) There are no funds available from which to award attorney fees.
- (7) All other issues are moot.

Permanent disability is based on the reports from Dr. John C. Mullen, Labor Code Section 4062.9, and the recommended permanent disability rating which was served on January 9, 1997.


Applicant is awarded permanent disability of 0%. There are no funds from which to award attorney fees.




OPINION ON DECISION
